

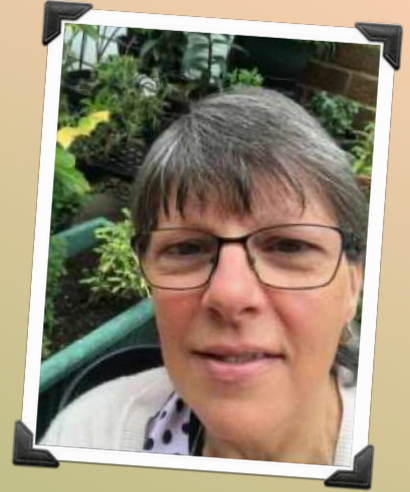
Mrs Ferris
