The Northamptonshire County Schools Challenge is open to all schools with key stage 3 provision.



Working in teams of no more than 8, we would like students to design an innovative product or service to help stop young people from carrying knives and to prevent knife crime.


Students will gain a greater awareness of the possible devastating effects of carrying knives, while the aim of their product/service will be to reduce the number of young people carrying bladed weapons, and potentially result in a reduction in knife crime.

One team per school will be invited to our semi-finals being held on 25th and 26th June 2019. As well as competing in a Dragons' Den style event, teams will have the opportunity to experience the work of our emergency services.

The top eight teams will go forward to our Grand Final on 8th July 2019 at the Castle Theatre, Wellingborough, where the winning team will receive funding to make their idea a reality.
